Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (2), Perishable Foods Were Not Stored to Protect Against Spoilage. (1), and A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Perishable Foods Were Not Stored to Protect Against Spoilage.**

Lunch boxes for the children in the classroom for preschoolers were sitting on a table and not stored in the kitchen refrigerator upon my arrival. The staff stated they are normally placed in the refrigerator daily but th

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A hole was observed under the fence of the playground used by preschoolers. It was located beside the air conditioning unit fence. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/26/2025

Apr 3, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

No activity plans were available for the classroom for infants and toddlers. The activity plan for the preschoolers was dated January 27, 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from prov

● **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The last fired drill was documented in October 2024. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/10/2025

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Four "D" batteries were observed sitting on a shelf in the classroom for infant/toddlers. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/10/2025
