Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Children Used Space That Was Not Approved. (1), Minimum Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes for the Number and Ages of Children in Care Were Not Met. (1), and All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Children Used Space That Was Not Approved.**

Upon arrival three children aged four and five were being cared for in the Director's office due to staffing shortage. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/30/2026

● **Minimum Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes for the Number and Ages of Children in Care Were Not Met.**

Twenty-one children in space #6 from three to five were observed being cared for. The group size maximum is twenty. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

In space #2 the wall near the cots are chipped and are not in good repair. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/30/2026

● **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

Fire drills were not conducted for the last four months. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/23/2026

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Children under 12 months had access to items that are choking hazards from the trash to treasure program within the facility. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/30/2026
