Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1), A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking. (1), and Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
