The sink in the preschool bathroom has a broken seal from the wall and the air vent cover in the school age bathroom is rusted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/16/2026

● **Incident Logs Were Not Completed and Maintained as Required.**

An incident log was not maintained for the completed incident reports. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/15/2025

● **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

A shelter-in-place or lockdown drill was not completed in February 2025 as required. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/15/2025

● **The Trained Staff Did Not Review the EPR Plan Annually or When Information in the Plan Changed to Ensure All Information Was Current.**

Documentation was not available to verify the required annual review and/or update of the facility's EPR plan. Violation confirmed corrected by letter
