In Space 4 there was not an available lesson plan for review. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/19/2025

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. In Space 2 an electrical power box was missing

● **All Staff Records, Except Financial Records, Were Not Made Available for Review.**

Three substitutes that were working in the classrooms did not have files available for review. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/19/2025
