The administrator stated food is catered in and does not know what is being served until the food arrives. Food is recorded at the time of receipt daily. Meals are not planned one week ahead. Violation co

- **Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook.**

Menu for lunch was not posted to be easily seen by parents. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 1/16/2026

- **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

At the base of the slides and exit/entry points, the resilient surfacing depth measured 3 to 4 inches. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 1/23/2026
