Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (1), All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1), and All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In space #5, the mini blind on the exit door was broken and missing pieces. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/1/2026

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

In both outdoor play areas, three Little Tikes climbing structures that measured more than 18 inches high were not installed over protective surfacing. Violation confirmed corrected by let

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**

● **The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of.**

Accessible to children in both outdoor play areas, there were broken dolls, dump trucks, toy kitchen sets with missing doors, musical
