Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (2), Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (1), and Discipline Was Not Appropriate for the Child's Age and Development. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met.**

In space #3, there was one child, one year of age grouped with one child, three years of age. The staff/child ratio for the youngest child was not met. There were eighteen children present with two teachers in space #3. The

● **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

In the hallway leading to all classrooms, there were peeling paint on twelve entrance doors and two window seals. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **Discipline Was Not Appropriate for the Child's Age and Development.**

During a review of video footage of space #6, A teacher was observed holding a child's hand (three years of age) and walking around the classroom for approximately ten minutes. Violation corrected during visit
