Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions. (1), Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), and Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions.**

The age range for this facility is children two (2) years of age to five (5) years of age. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 2/12/2026

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

One (1) child that was one (1) year of age was left alone in space#3 eating. Additionally, the group moved to space #3 from space # 2 for snacks. Five (5) children between the ages of two (2) years of age to five (5) years of age

● **Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook.**

The Menu was posted in the kitchen and dated for 1/19-1/23/2026. Violation corrected during visit

● **Diaper Changing Surfaces Were Not Cleaned with a Detergent Solution and Disinfected After Each Use.**

Today three (3) diaper changes were observed consecutively, between the first and second diaper change observed the changing mat was not cleaned and disinfected. Violation confirmed cor

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
