Upon arrival at the center, a staff member assigned to space #4 left the classroom space to open the front door. In space #4, seven (7) children, one year of age, were in care with one
- **The Written Feeding Plan Was Not Modified as the Child's Needs Changed.**
An infant feeding plan was not updated to reflect the intake of baby food. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 12/17/2025
- **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
