● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

The landscape fabric beneath the mulch under the merry go round and the climbing dome was exposed causing a tripping hazard. The mulch beneath the stationary climbing dome was one inch in depth rather than the re
