● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Active ant piles were observed throughout the outdoor play area. The top on a green storage bin in Space #4 was exposing rough edges. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/27/2026

● **The Health Assessment Did Not Include a Hearing Screening.**

Hearing screenings were not on file for two preschool children enrolled. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/27/2026

● **All Staff Records, Except Financial Records, Were Not Made Available for Review.**

A staff file for an uncompensated provider working in Space #1 with required documentation was not available for review during the visit. Violation corrected during visit

● **Food Substitution Was Not of Comparable Food Value or Recorded on the Menu Prior to the Meal or Snack Being Served.**

Cheerios substituted for pancake pups was not recorded on the menus posted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/23/2025
