An activity plan was missing from all three classrooms. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/13/2026

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

One playground area had a lot of materials on it making it crowded. There were a lot of toys and items around the climbers that were also in the fall zones that was hazardous. A picket on the ramp going to the la

● **Toxic Plants Were Accessible to Children.**

There was at least one toxic plant below five (5) feet, which makes it accessible to children. Violation corrected during visit

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

In space 1A, a prescription diaper cream was not locked. Since it is a prescription cream, it must be locked up. Violation confirmed corrected by letter receive
