Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (2), Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information. (2), and Staff Did Not Wash Their Hands Thoroughly Before Beginning Work, Before/after Handling Food, Before Bottle Feeding or Serving to Other Children, After... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
