In space #103, baby wipes were observed on a blue/purple stool in the bathroom and on a shelf in the classroom – “keep out of reach of children,” were on the labels. The baby wipes were accessible to the children in care. V

- **Electric Fans Were Not Mounted Out of Reach or Did Not Have a Mesh Guard to Prevent Access.**

There were two electric fans in space #103 – one was on top of a file cabinet out of reach of children and the other was sitting on the floor by the carpeted/group time area. Violation confirme

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
