● **Special Diet or Food Allergy Information Was Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen in Food Preparation and Eating Areas.**

According to information on the application, one child was allergic to eggs. The information was not posted. Violation pending provider response

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

Additional surfacing was needed for all the larger pieces of play equipment. The larger pieces would be considered stationary, because they were too large for the children to move. Gras

● **Monthly Playground Inspections Were Not Completed And/or They Were Not Completed by an Individual Trained in Playground Safety Requirements.**

The last documented outdoor inspection was completed on 3/20/26. Violation pending provider response

● **The EMC Plan Was Not Reviewed with All Staff Annually and Whenever the Plan Was Revised.**

There was no verification that the administrative staff or one teacher had reviewed the plan within the past year. Violation pending provider response

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. The acting director had not completed current First
