(2), Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), and Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. Five outlets were uncovered in EL1. Violation

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

Two prescriptions for one staff member were not in locked storage. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/12/2025
