Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (2), Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1), and Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

In space #1, eleven diaper rash creams and one package of Boogie saline nose wipes were observed in an unlocked cabinet below the diaper changing table accessib

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

In space #1, eleven plastic packages of wipes and two plastic packages of diapers with safety warnings were observed in an unlocked cabinet

● **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

In space #1, the sleep position for one child, five months of age, was not documented on the sleep chart at 1:23pm, on March 18, 2026. In space #1, the sleep position for one child, six months of age, was not documented on the sl
