None of the 5 findings were critical.

One child did not have a hearing screening completed. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/11/2026

● **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

Fire drills record was incomplete for the month of December 2024 and February 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/19/2025

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A safe outdoor was not provided for the children in care. On the playground, there are large roots growing out of the ground they may cause tripping hazards. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from p

● **Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet.**

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. The fence did not meet the 4ft requirement. The fence measured 44 inches all around. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received f

● **The EMC Plan Was Not Reviewed with All Staff Annually and Whenever the Plan Was Revised.**

The EMC plan was not updated and reviewed with staff annually. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/19/2025
