Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1), Medical Exam or Health Assessment Record Was Not on File Before or Within 30 Days After Admission. (1), and A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

One child's enrollment file was missing their medical/health assessment. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 3/12/2025

**Oct 23, 2024** 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

A current lesson plan was not posted in the preK classroom. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/28/2024

● **Each Child's Bed, Cot, or 2" Mat Was Not Individually Assigned and Identified.**

The cots were not individually labeled in the preK classroom. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/28/2024
