Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (2), Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment. (1), and Each Employee's Personnel File Did Not Contain an Annual Staff Evaluation and a Staff Development Plan. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A plastic bag was on the ground on the toddler playground. Violation corrected during visit

- **Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment.**

One staff member did not complete medication in child care training within the first year of employment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/5/2026

Apr 9, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

In space #2, there were diapers in plastic bags located on a low shelf in the bathroom. Violation corrected during visit

- **Each Employee's Personnel File Did Not Contain an Annual Staff Evaluation and a Staff Development Plan.**

One employee did not have a annual staff development plan on file. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/22/2025
