Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), Center Did Not Maintain a Record of Daily Attendance. (1), and Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

Upon arrival, space #1 was observed in the outdoor space. The two (2) staff members assigned to space #1 were observed sitting on a picnic table under the shade structure located directly outside. A child had gotten stuck for sever
