In Space 7, there was one topical ointment with an expired authorization. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/3/2026

● **Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment.**

One staff member did not complete the medication administration training topic within one year of employment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/3/2026
