(2), Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent... (1), and Drinking Water Was Not Freely Available to Children of All Ages. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A 2 year old child was left unattended in the Prep 2 classroom for eleven (11) minutes. Violation corrected during visit
