Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Meals/snacks Did Not Comply with the Meal Patterns for Children in Child Care Programs. (1), Children Were Not Provided a Meal or Snack a Minimum of Every Four Hours. (1), and Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Meals/snacks Did Not Comply with the Meal Patterns for Children in Child Care Programs.**

A vegetable was not served with the lunch meal on 4-30-26. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/21/2026

● **Children Were Not Provided a Meal or Snack a Minimum of Every Four Hours.**

On 4-30-26, the breakfast and lunch meals were 4 to 4.5 hours apart. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/21/2026

● **Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met.**

More than five children are routinely present in space during between 6:30 and 7:10 am. In addition, as many as twelve children, including children less than one year of age, are present in this same classroom with two staff members.
