Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were NC Pre-K Program Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (1), The Health Assessment Did Not Include a Hearing Screening. (1), and Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

The last shelter in place and/or lockdown drill was conducted on October 2, 2023. A lockdown drill was conducted during my visit today. Violation corrected during visit
