Four of the six children's files reviewed did not have a signed statement of receipt of the summary of the NC Child Care Law. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from prov
- **A Current Activity Plan Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**
In space 4, the lesson plan posted was not dated and did not reflect current activities. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/16/2025
- **When Three Year Old Children and Older Were in Care, the Materials and Equipment in the Activity Area Was Not in Sufficient Quantity to Allow at Least Three...**
