(1), and Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1). ● **Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Planned at Least 1 Week Ahead and Dated.**

The current menu available for review and posted was dated August 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/30/2026

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**

● **The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of.**
