Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy. (1), For Children Under Two Years of Age, Time and Space for Sleeping, Eating, Toileting, Diaper Changing, and Playing Was Not Provided According to Child's Needs. (1), and New Staff, Who Had Contact with Children, Did Not Receive at Least 16 Hrs. Orientation Within First 6 Weeks. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A nine month old was placed in a car seat for the last 15 minutes of the day. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **New Staff, Who Had Contact with Children, Did Not Receive at Least 16 Hrs. Orientation Within First 6 Weeks.**

T. Turner whose date of employment began on 2/6/2025 had not received orientation at the time of the visit. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/

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● **The Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma Policy Was Not Reviewed with New Staff Prior to Providing Care with Children And/or a Signed...**

● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

Medication authorization for three infants was did not have the correct dosage amount. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/9/2024

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
