Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. The last fire inspection was conducted April

● **A Summary of the NC Child Care Law Was Not Given to a Parent of Every Child Enrolled in the Center.**

See children's Records Form Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/24/2026

● **A Current Schedule Was Not Posted for Each Group of Children for Reference.**

Three classrooms did not have a schedule posted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/24/2026

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

The outdoor play areas had two picnic tables that had chipped wood. There was a large piece of wood with two large nails sticking out of it in the middle of the school age playground. There was dead pieces of wood

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. There were uncovered outlets in two classrooms.
