(1), On or Before the First Day of Work, All Staff, Including the Director and Individuals Who Volunteer More Than Once per Week Did Not Provide Results Indicating... (1), and Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

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● **Gates to the Fenced Outdoor Play Area Did Not Remain Closed While Children Occupied the Area.**
