In space #2, documentation was not available for review in the classroom. This was corrected by posting the applicable staff/child ratio chart. Violation corrected during visit

In space #3, the activity plan was dated 1/6- 1/20/26. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/5/2026

On the toddler outdoor learning environment, the water play structure had a broken plastic part near the faucet. This was corrected by removing the structure from the playground. Violation corrected during visit
