One child with a date of enrollment of 09/05/2023 did not have a child health assessment on file. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

enrollment was not on file in the home. One child with a date of enrollment of 09/05/2023 did not have a signed acknowledgement state

● **The Operator Did Not Conduct a Quarterly Lockdown or Shelter-in-place Drill and or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The last shelter-in-place or lockdown drill was completed on 08/09/2023. No shelter-in-place or lockdown drill was recorded for November 2023. The owner/operator recor
