Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Monthly Playground Inspections Were Not Completed And/or They Were Not Completed by an Individual Trained in Playground Safety Requirements. (1), Safe Pick-up and Delivery Procedures Were Not Communicated to Parents And/or Were Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen by the Parents. (1), and A Minimum of Two Staff Members Were Not on Site at All Times While Children Were Present at the Facility. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Safe Pick-up and Delivery Procedures Were Not Communicated to Parents And/or Were Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen by the Parents.**

Safe pick up and delivery procedures was not posted in space 108. Violation corrected during visit

May 16, 2024 2 Findings ● 2 Important

- **A Minimum of Two Staff Members Were Not on Site at All Times While Children Were Present at the Facility.**

One teacher stepped into the hallway leaving only one teacher in the classroom. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/31/2024
