(2), A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), and All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
