Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. The last fire inspection on file is dated Ma

● **A Summary of the NC Child Care Law Was Not Given to a Parent of Every Child Enrolled in the Center.**

Five (5) children did not have a summary on file signed and dated on or before enrollment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/13/2026

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

In Spaces 6, 7, 8 and 9 rusty bolts were exposed on the toilets. In Space 7, broken tile was observed at the threshold of the door and in the bathroom. Fungal growth was observed on the white picket fence located

● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

In Space 1, A permission to administer form named Epi-pen as medication and gave instructions for Cetrizine dosage only. In Space 2, Cortisone and Vicks did not have a permission to administer form signed by a phy

● **Leftover Medicines Were Not Returned to the Parent After the Course of Treatment Was Completed, After Authorization Was Withdrawn or After Authorization Had...**
