(2), Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1), and Each Child Did Not Have an Opportunity to Be Outdoors Daily, if Weather Conditions Permitted. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A two-year-old child in Space 3 was observed being forcefully grabbed by the arm by a teacher, lifted, and carried to the bathroom for diaper changing. Violation c

- **Each Child Did Not Have an Opportunity to Be Outdoors Daily, if Weather Conditions Permitted.**

Infants in space 1 were not taken outside daily as scheduled. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/20/2026

- **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

In space 8 it was observed that the cabinet door was broken off the hinges, the soap dispenser for the children was broken and children can not get soap to wash hands, and the blinds were broken. Violation corrected during visit
