In space #12, I observed an activity plan not current, it was dated for 2/2/26 through 2/6/26. Violation corrected during visit

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

In space #12, I observed a kitchen set in the dramatic center that was broken. I observed a few wooden planks that were broken and in need of repair by the fence on the playground used by older children. Violation confirmed correc

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**

● **A Drug or Medicine Was Administered After Its Expiration Date.**
