(1), and A Valid Qualification Letter Was Not on File and Available to Review at the Facility. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

The blinds on the door were bent in toward the classroom creating a protrusion at the child's eye level. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/27/2026

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

There was a bottle of Benadryl unlocked. Violation corrected during visit

The therapist working with children alone did not have a letter on file. She is qualified but did not have the letter on file. Violation corrected during visit
