One (1) child, RI, with a diagnosed food allergy did not have emergency medication onsite. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/26/2025

● **Application Did Not Have a Medical Action Plan Attached for Any Child with Health Care Needs Such as Allergies, Asthma, or Other Chronic Conditions That...**
