(1), Leftover Medicines Were Not Returned to the Parent After the Course of Treatment Was Completed, After Authorization Was Withdrawn or After Authorization Had... (1), and When Medication Was Administered, Documentation Was Not Completed or Maintained for 6 Months And/or the Documentation Did Not Include the Required Information. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In the classroom for toddlers, there were three children with asthma medication, the times the medication was given was docum

● **The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of.**

There was small pieces of glass observed on the playground. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/26/20
