(1), and All Openings to the Outer Air Were Not Protected Against the Entrance of Flying Insects. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

A power tool (floor cleaning machine) was monitored plugged into an electrical socket charging in the cafeteria, accessible to ASEP children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/3/

employment. A staff person hired February 12, 2024 did not obtain BSAC within three months of employment. Violation confirmed cor

● **All Openings to the Outer Air Were Not Protected Against the Entrance of Flying Insects.**

Although, they were not flying, there were at least five small bugs on the floor in the cafeteria. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/7/2023
