Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Appropriate Discipline Practices Were Not Followed. (1), Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1), and Child Was Handled Roughly. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Nov 5, 2024 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **Appropriate Discipline Practices Were Not Followed.**

One (1) caregiver placed a child in time out for nine (9) minutes and slapped a child's arm to stop a behavior. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 11/14/2024

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

One (1) caregiver repeatedly yelled at children in a threatening manner. The one (1) caregiver also refused to assist developmentally delayed children with toileti

● **Child Was Handled Roughly.**

One (1) caregiver dragged a child by their feet from under a table and lifted a child by their arms to move the child to an alternate space. The one (1) caregiver lifted a child by the arm and dropped the child into a bean bag chair for "time out". Violation

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**
