None of the 2 findings were critical.

Neosporin packets and an enrolled child's topical (skin) medication were stored on a shelf that was five feet above the floor but not in locked storage. Violation pending provider response
- **Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, and Products Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser and Any Substance That May Be...**
hazardous to a child if ingested, inhaled, or handled were not kept in locked storage when children were in care.
