Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1), All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1), and All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

The facility's last shelter-in-place or lockdown drill was dated 7/1/25. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/17/2025

Oct 14, 2024 3 Findings ● 3 Important

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

Play equipment that cannot be moved by at least one person, measured approximately 21 inches high and was not placed over protective surfacing. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

On the outdoor area, there was a large table against the building with open cracks around the edge. The table was removed from the playground. Violation corrected during visit

● **The Child Care Center Premises, Including the Outdoor Learning Environment, Was Not Clean, Drained to Minimize Standing Water, Free of Litter and Hazards,...**

and/or maintained in a manner which does not create conditions that attract or harbor pests. Grass was growing in the mulch. Viol
