- **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

Two infants sleeping in Room 1 were observed wrapped in blankets in their cribs. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/9/2025

- **Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

A drill was not logged on the drill sheet for April-June 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/9/2025
