(1), Application Was Not on File for Each Enrolled Child, Including His/her Own Preschool Child(ren) Who Are Not School-age. (1), and Swimming Pool on the Premises Was Not Enclosed by a Fence at Least Four Feet High, or the Fence Was Not Locked, to Prevent Access by Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A child who enrolled in March 2026 did not have all required paperwork on file. The file was missing the application, discipline policy, shaken baby policy, animal
- **Swimming Pool on the Premises Was Not Enclosed by a Fence at Least Four Feet High, or the Fence Was Not Locked, to Prevent Access by Children.**
Access to the above-ground pool was not prevented by separating the pool from the play area by a fence, or by ensuring the ladder was removed

- **Number of Preschool Children Exceeded Five Children, Including the Provider's Own Preschool Children.**
Seven preschool-aged children were present. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 12/17/2025
