Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care. (1), All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care. (1), and Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. At least one staff member did not complete the first

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. At least one staff member had not completed the CP

Feb 11, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

A staff member made threatening statements to a three-year-old child and made a striking motion towards the child. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit

- **A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking.**

A staff member hit a three-year-old child in the face with an open hand. The same staff member was observed hitting two three-year-old children on the bottom and

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● **There Was a Substantiation of Child Maltreatment.**

Pursuant to its investigation, the Division has confirmed sufficient information to determine child maltreatment.
