Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (1), Children Between 12 and 24 Months of Age Were Grouped with Children 3 Years of Age or Older. (1), and Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met.**

Enhanced staff/child ratios and group sizes were not in compliance on April 16th and April 20th, 2026 in Space 6a and April 20th-24th in Space 2. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/15/2026

**Jan 8, 2026** 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **Children Between 12 and 24 Months of Age Were Grouped with Children 3 Years of Age or Older.**

In Space 1, there was one child, age one, grouped with children 3 years of age. Violation corrected during visit

● **Equipment and Furnishings Not Meeting the Requirements Outlined in Child Care .0601(b) and (C) Were Not Removed or Made Inaccessible.**

In Space 5A there were two(2) battery operated toys that were not working. In Space 5B, there were six(6) battery operated toys that were not working.

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

In Space 1, there were eleven(11) bags of wipes accessible under the unlocked diaper table. Violation corrected during visit
