(1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A schedule was not posted in Space #3. Violation corrected during visit

The black border enclosing the surfacing around the play equipment on the playground was cracked, creating an opening where children's fingers could be stuck. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Documentation was not on file to verify completion of

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Documentation was not on file to verify completion

● **A Valid Qualification Letter Was Not on File and Available to Review at the Facility.**

Valid qualification letters were not on file for three employees and a substitute reported working with the program for more than 90 days. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provid
